

Financial Assistance

Financial Assistance is available to eligible Honorably discharged veterans or Servicemembers and their dependent family members, and eligible surviving spouses of Honorably discharged veterans.

Financial Assistance is never given in cash to the veteran. Any eligible expenses are paid directly to the vendor(s) on behalf of the veteran.

The VAC is able to assist with:

Rent/Mortgage Payments
Utility Payments
Food Vouchers

Fuel Vouchers

Eligibility for financial assistance is determined by a variety of factors such as: Time in Service, Resident of McHenry County, Income & Need.

Transportation Service

The Veterans Assistance Commission runs a daily shuttle to the Captain James A Lovell Federal Healthcare Center (Excluding Weekends and Federal Holidays). You must be a McHenry County Resident in order to utilize this service and be registered with the VAC.

Crystal Lake Burger King on Rte. 14


